



## SAFETY AND SECURITY

Our monthly SAPS Meeting took place on the 16th August 2016 to consider July's crime statistics.

Motor vehicle theft is still a concern and Brendan van der Merwe requested SAPS to report back on what side of the Station the thefts are taking place so that SAPS, ST3 and Astrosec can find a way to monitor the situation and reduce the risk. The street on both sides of the Blackheath Station are named Station Road and so it is imperative that we identify the true location of the crimes to see if there is a pattern emerging.

BCID Trailer: Patrols are scheduled and are done every hour during the day. The Trailer's cameras are fully operational.

The City's Traffic Services held a Vehicle Check Point (VCP) that was attended by 4 Officers between 11:00am and 12:30pm and the Traffic Department Statistics are as follows:

Using cellular phone/device while driving: **1**  
Safety Belts not worn/good working order: **24**  
Taxi operating without PDP: **1**  
Taxi failed to produce PDP on demand: **1**  
Tyres (tread depth/worn/canvas/bulge/cuts): **8**  
Number plates not affixed: **1**  
Unregistered/ Unlicensed motor vehicle: **14**  
Failed to display licence as prescribed: **14**  
Unlicensed Drivers: **16**  
Failed to produce drivers licence on demand: **16**

A total of **96** fines were issued.

### **Action Steps**

- Police and ST3 to continue with visible patrolling.
- VCP to be held in the area including SAPS, Law Enforcement and Traffic Dept.
- SAPS to investigate on which side of the Station the Theft of Motor Vehicles is taking place.
- Task SAPS to do Crime Prevention in the Happy Valley area.

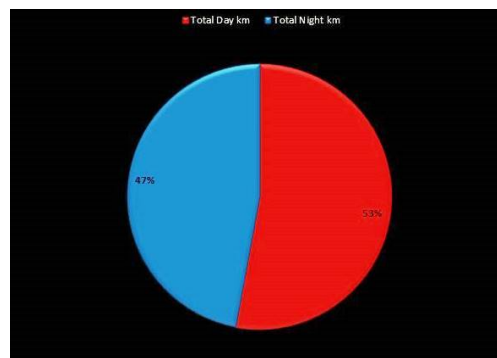
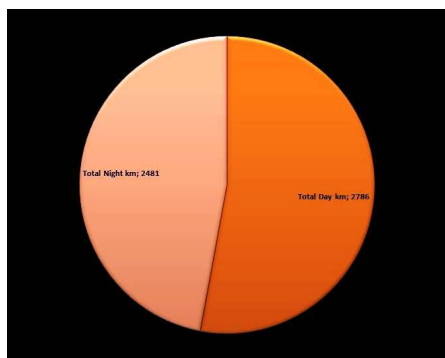
