The Blackheath City Improvement District and the Mfuleni SAPS at our May meeting entered into a Memorandum of Understanding whereby the Mfuleni SAPS Station Commander committed to supporting the partnership with the Business Forum in the interest of safety and crime prevention.

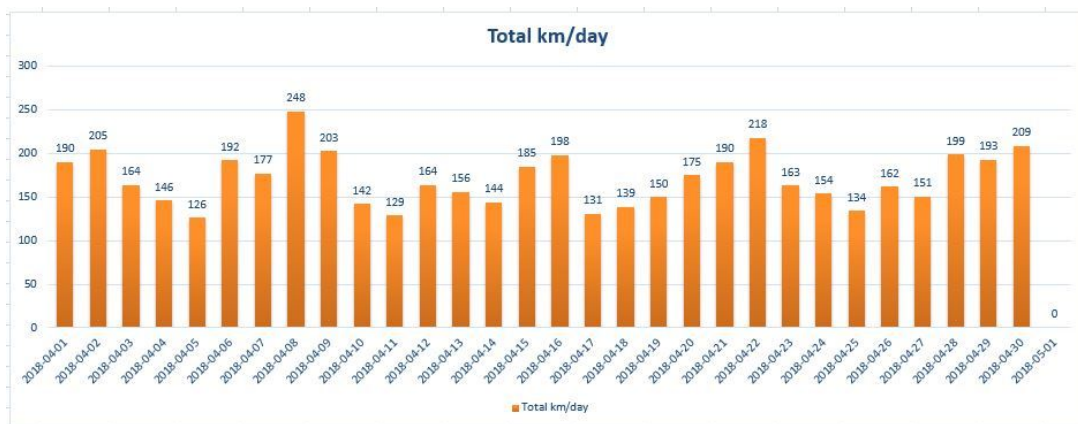
This forum has been in operation since 2006 and has had little and sometimes no support from SAPS and hosts all of the Law Enforcement Agencies that meet once a month to discuss crime in Blackheath and to identify crime trends. We also plan operations, road blocks and vehicle check points as well as taxi operations.

Brigadier Pieter Galant committed to support business in reporting crime and in dedicating resources to the relationship with the Blackheath Industrial Area. We have had several serious crimes committed within the Industrial area during this year.

The police stats for April showed a reduction in crime, although there was a single vehicle theft from the Blackheath Station.

Our Security Service provider (ST3 Security) have provided us with the underlying statistics for April 2018.
